

# *Trees of Olive*

## *The True, Holy Name of the True God - the Great Yehovah Elohim, the True God of the Earth and Universe*

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### The Title-Name “Lord”

The original title-name “**lord**” comes from ancient Babylon (ancient Mesopotamia - the ancient Cities and Tower of Babel - Genesis 11:1-9). It was a title-name that was used in referring to warlords-chieftains, and for the members of the elite society of ancient Babylon. The title-name “**lord**” meant “**master, ruler, one who owns land; very influential person, nobleman.**” The word “**landlord**” of real estate property comes from this title-name. Secondly, it must be fully realized that the various warlords-chieftains, and the various members of the elite society of ancient Babylon, were considered as “**gods**” over the people; and they were called lords - gods by the people. Thirdly, the title-name “**lord**” was used to refer to various different “**pagan gods and deities**” in the ancient world.

The title-name “**lord**” was adopted from ancient Babylon by the British elite society, and was used to refer to individuals with some authority, control, or power over others, and also was used by the British’s elite society to refer to their elite society as “**lords - masters, rulers**” over the masses of their people, and as owners of all the land property, and nobles of their people.

### The Names of “Yehovah and Elohim”

When the Bible was translated from the original Hebrew Language into the English Language it is alleged that the translators of the Bible did not want to use the true name of “**Yehovah**” in their translation and transliteration of the Hebrew Holy Scriptures; therefore, they decided to adopt and use the title-name of “**lord**” from the ancient Babylonian, pagan title-name, for the translated name for Yehovah in translating the Old Testament. The ancient Babylonian, pagan title-name “**lord**”

should have never been used as a substitute for the true and proper name of the true God of and over all people and nations, and of and over the entire Earth and the Universe, the name of **“Yehovah.”**

The true name of the true God of the Universe, the name **“Yehovah”** is listed **“6,828 times”** all throughout the Hebrew, Old Testament, and the name **“Yah”** is listed **“49 times.”** It is now time to return to using the true and proper name of the true God of the Universe, the name **“Yehovah”** in the reading of the Holy Scriptures of the Old Testament, as well as return to using the true and proper name of **“Yehovah”** in all of our Prayers, and in singing of songs and praises unto the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim, and also in our daily conversations in referring to the Great Yehovah Elohim.

### The Title-Name of “Adon”

The title-name **“Adon”** was first used starting with the ancient Cities and Tower of Babel, which ancient Cities and Tower of Babel were ancient Mesopotamia (ancient Babylon), the first man-made civilization after the Flood of Noah. Historians refer to this time period as the **“Akkadian-Babylonian Empires,”** and also which time period is alleged to be from about 2334 B.C.E. to about 2003 B.C.E. It must be noted that the Flood of Noah took place in the year **“2343 B.C.E.”**; therefore, the Akkadian-Babylonian Empires were built after the year 2343 B.C.E. The ancient Akkadians-Babylonians used the title-name of Adon in referring to leaders, rulers, masters, earthly fathers, as well as to their various pagan gods. It is very important to note that the ancient Akkadian-Babylonian people viewed many of their early leaders, rulers and masters as being born of the gods. Secondly, the title-name of Adon was used by the various Semitic people in the ancient world, and even by the Grecian people, especially in the worship of their pagan god **“Adonis.”**

### The Hebrew Bible, and the Title-Name “Adon”

There are **“334 places”** in the Hebrew Bible (the Old Testament) where the title-name **“Adon”** appears. Of these 334 places only **“two times”** were the title-name Adon ever used in the entire Torah in referring to the Great Yehovah Elohim, and in these two places it is written **“Adon Yehovah.”** (Read: Exodus 23:17; 34:23). Secondly, of the 334 places where the title-name Adon appears only **“17 times”** was this title-name Adon ever used in referring to the Great Yehovah Elohim. Thirdly, of the remaining **“317 times”** where the title-name Adon appears throughout the entire Tanack (the Old Testament) it was mostly used as a title-name in referring to earthly rulers, masters, kings, earthly fathers, and various individuals of leadership. For example, Abraham, Esau, Joseph, Potipher, Moses,

and Nebuchadnezzar, and even Angels, were all referred to as “Adon,” or rather “Adoni,” and similar title-names stemming from the root title-name of Adon.

In the English translation of the Tanack (the Old Testament) the word “lord” is mostly used as a translated title-name for both the name of Yehovah, and also for the title-name of Adon of the Hebrew text.

Since the time of the death of Moses, and especially since the time of the dispersion of the Israelites throughout this entire Earth, so many of the Israelites were, and have been, influenced by various cultures of the surrounding nations, including in the adoption of various words and title-names. It is now time to return back to the true worship of the Great Yehovah Elohim, and refer to the Great Yehovah Elohim in correctly using his correct name, which is Yehovah Elohim.

### The Name of “Ha-Shem”

When Rabbinic Judaism was created “after” the destruction of the Second Temple in the City of Jerusalem in 70 C.E., the Pharisees-Rabbinic rabbis adopted the practice of using the word/name of “Ha-Shem,” which simply means “the Name” to refer to the true and Great God of the Universe, instead of using the true and proper name of “Yehovah.” It must be known and fully recognized that the practice of using the name of “Ha-Shem” to refer to the true God was only adopted after, and used only after 70 C.E. by Rabbinic Judaism. Since the Garden of Eden, and all throughout the Old Testament (the Tanack), the true and proper name of Yehovah was always used to refer to the true God of the Universe, including in daily conversations among the masses of the people. Using the word/name of “Ha-Shem,” instead of using the true and proper name of “Yehovah,” in referring to the true God of the Universe, has been an act of “profaning” of the true and proper, Holy Name of the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim.

The word/name of “Ha-Shem” should “never” be used in Prayers, nor in songs, nor in daily conversation when referring to the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim. Read the various Holy Scriptures concerning the profaning of the Holy Name of true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim.

If the true God of the Universe did not want all people and nations to use, nor to pronounce his true and proper, Holy Name, the Holy Name of “Yehovah,” then he would not have allowed it to be known, nor to be written, nor to have been pronounced and used in daily conversations all throughout the entire Holy Scriptures of the Old Testament. As previously mentioned, the true and proper, Holy Name of the true God of the Universe, the name “Yehovah” is listed “6,828

times” all throughout the Hebrew, Old Testament. (Also read: Jeremiah 44:22-26; Isaiah 4:3; Ezekiel 36:18-23; Ezekiel 9:17)

**Commanded to “NEVER” Forget  
the True, Holy Name of Yehovah Elohim**

There are many Holy Scripture verses that show that the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim, desires for all of his true, holy saints, and for all people and nations, to call him by his true and proper, Holy Name of **“Yehovah.”** The true, holy saints of the true God are commanded to **“Never Forget”** the true, Holy Name of the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim. The true, holy saints of the true God are to gladly come to know, pronounce, say, and to pray to and refer to the true God of the Universe by his true and proper, Holy Name - the true name of **“Yehovah Elohim.”**

**In Jeremiah 23:25-37 it is written:** “I have heard what the **prophets said, that prophesy lies in My Name,** saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed. How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, they are **prophets of the deceit** of their own heart; **which think to cause my people to forget My Name by their dreams** which they tell every man to his neighbor, as their fathers have forgotten My Name for Baal.”

The true God - the Great Yehovah Elohim, **“commands”** for his holy saints to **“declare and speak”** his Holy Name, and to **“praise”** his Holy Name - the name of Yehovah Elohim. The true, holy saints of the true God are to **“Pray”** in the true, Holy Name of the Great Yehovah Elohim; and they are to **“Go Forth”** in the true, Holy Name of the Great Yehovah Elohim; and also they are to always **“remember, and to never forget”** the true, Holy Name of the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim.

It is prophesied in the Book of Zephaniah that the people (all people and nations) will return unto, and call upon, the name of **“Yehovah”** in a pure language, which language is the Hebrew Language. All people and nations are to return to, and speak the true, Holy Name of the Great Yehovah Elohim, and in using his true, Holy Name - the name of Yehovah Elohim.

**In Zephaniah 3:9 it is written:** “For then will I turn to the people a pure language, **that they may all call upon the Name of the Yehovah,** to serve him with one consent.”

It must be known, and remembered how that young, King David went against Goliath in the true, Holy Name of the Great Yehovah Elohim. When a

true, holy saint of the Great Yehovah Elohim goes against their enemies, they should always go forth in the Name of the true God of the Universe - the Great Yehovah Elohim.

**In I Samuel 17:45-47 it is written:** “Then said David to the Philistine, You come to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to you **in the Name of the Yehovah of Hosts**, the Elohim of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day will the **Yehovah** deliver you into mine hand; and I will smite you, and take your head from you; and I will give the carcasses of the host of the Philistines this day unto the fowls of the air, and to the wild beasts of the Earth; that all the Earth may know that there is an Elohim in Israel. And all this assembly shall know that the **Yehovah** saves not with sword and spear: for the battle is the **Yehovah’s**, and he will give you into our hands.”

Do indeed read, study, examine, know, and understand the true, Holy Scriptures concerning the true, Holy Name of the Great Yehovah Elohim - on an independent basis. (Also read: Exodus 3:13-16; Numbers 6:27; Deuteronomy 10:20; II Chronicles 6:24-27; Psalm 20:1; Joel 2:28-32)

### **Holy Names of the Great Yehovah Elohim**

- 1) **Yehovah** - (pronounced “Jehovah” by many in the English language, yet should be written and pronounced “**Yehovah**”) (Genesis 2:4)
- 2) **Elohim** - Meaning “God” (Genesis 1:1; Psalm 19:1)
- 3) **Yehovah-El-Shaddai** - Yehovah Almighty (Genesis 17:1; Psalm 91:1)
- 4) **Yehovah-Jireh** - Yehovah will Provide (Genesis 22:13-14)
- 5) **Yehovah-MeKaddishkem** - Yehovah your Sanctifier (Exodus 31:13)
- 6) **Yehovah-Nissi** - Yehovah our Banner (Exodus 17:15)
- 7) **Yehovah-Shabbaoth** - Yehovah of Hosts (Isaiah 6:1-3)
- 8) **Yehovah-Shalom** - Yehovah is Peace (Judges 6:24)
- 9) **Yehovah-Shammah** - Yehovah is Present (Ezekiel 48:35)
- 10) **Yehovah-Rapha** - Yehovah our Healer (Exodus 16:26)

- 11) Yehovah-Rohi - Yehovah my Shepherd (Psalm 23:1)
- 12) Yehovah-Tsidkenu - Yehovah our Righteousness (Jeremiah 23:6)
- 13) El-Elyon - Most High God (Genesis 14:17-20; Isaiah 14:13-14)
- 14) El-Olam - Everlasting God (Isaiah 40:28-31)
- 15) El-Roi - God Who Sees (Genesis 16:12)

Also,

- 16) Yehovah-Avinu - Yehovah, Our Father
- 17) Yehovah-Malkeinu - Yehovah, Our King

**Very Important Note:** Everyone, and especially all of the true, holy saints, should always try to remember to refer to the true God of the Universe - the Creator, and the Great and Supreme King, and the Ruler and Owner of and over all people and nations, and of and over the entire Earth and Universe, as “**Yehovah Elohim**” starting now, and do so forevermore throughout eternity.

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
