**Genesis 4:26** - “And to Seth, to him also there was born a son; and he called his name Enos: then began men to **Call upon the Name of the Yehovah.**”

**Genesis 12:8** - “And he removed from there unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, having Bethel on the west, and Hai on the east: and there he built an altar unto the Yehovah, and **called upon the Name of the Yehovah.**”

**Genesis 13:4** - “Unto the place of the altar, which he had made there at the first: and there Abram **called on the Name of the Yehovah.**”

**Genesis 21:33** - And Abraham planted a grove in Beer-sheba, and **called there on the Name of the Yehovah**, the everlasting Elohim.”

**Generis 22:14** - “And Abraham called the name of that place **Yehovah-jireh**: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the **Yehovah** it shall be seen.”

**Genesis 26:25** - “And he built an altar there, and called upon the **Name of the Yehovah** and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well.”

**Exodus 3:13** - “And Moses said unto **Elohim**, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The **Elohim** of your fathers has sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his **Name**? what shall I say unto them?”

**Exodus 3:15** - “And **Elohim** said moreover unto Moses, Thus shall you say unto the children of Israel, The **Yehovah Elohim** of your fathers, the **Elohim** of Abraham, the **Elohim** of Isaac, and the **Elohim** of Jacob, has sent me unto you: this is my **Name** forever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.”

Exodus 5:23 - “For since I came to Pharaoh to **u**speak in your Name, he has done evil to this people; neither have you delivered your people at all.”

Exodus 6:3 - “And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the **N**ame of Elohim Almighty, **u**but by my Name Yehovah was I not known to them.”

Exodus 9:16 - And in very deed for this cause have I raised you up, for to shew in you my power; and **u**that my Name may be declared throughout all the Earth.”

Exodus 15:3 - “The **Yehovah** is a man of war: the **Yehovah** is his **N**ame.”

Exodus 17:7 - “And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of the chiding of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the **Yehovah**, saying, Is the **Yehovah** among us, or not?”

Exodus 17:15 - “And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it **Yehovah-nissi:**”

Exodus 20:7 - “You shall not take the **N**ame of the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** in vain; for the **Yehovah** will not hold him guiltless that takes his **N**ame in vain.”

Exodus 20:24 - “An altar of Earth you shall make unto me, and shall sacrifice thereon your burnt offerings, and your peace offerings, your sheep, and your oxen: **u**in all places where I record my Name I will come unto you, and I will bless you.”

Exodus 23:21 - “Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: **u**for my Name is in him.”

Exodus 33:12 - “And Moses said unto the **Yehovah**, See, you say unto me, Bring up this people: and you have not let me know whom you will send with me. Yet you have said, I know you by name, and you have also found grace in my sight.”

Exodus 33:19 - “And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before you, and **u**I will proclaim the Name of the Yehovah before you; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy.”

Exodus 34:5 - And the **Yehovah** descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and **u**proclaimed the Name of the Yehovah.”

Exodus 34:4 - “For you shall worship no other **Elohim**: for the **Yehovah**, whose **N**ame is Jealous, is a jealous **Elohim**:”

Leviticus 18:21 - “And you shall not let any of your seed pass through the fire to Molech, neither shall you profane the **N**ame of your **Elohim**: I am the **Yehovah.**”

Leviticus 19:12 - “And you shall not swear by my **N**ame falsely, neither shall you profane the **N**ame of your **Elohim**: I am the **Yehovah.**”

**Leviticus 20:3** – “And I will set my face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he has given of his seed unto Molech, to defile my Sanctuary, and to profane my holy **Name**.”

**Leviticus 21:6** – “They shall be holy unto their **Elohim**, and not profane the **Name** of their **Elohim**: for the offerings of the **Yehovah** made by fire, and the bread of their **Elohim**, they do offer: therefore they shall be holy.”

**Leviticus 22:2** – “Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the holy things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not my holy **Name** in those things which they hallow unto me: I am the **Yehovah**.”

**Leviticus 22:32** – “Neither shall you profane my holy **Name**; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I am the **Yehovah** which hallow you,”

**Leviticus 24:11** – “And the Israelitish woman's son blasphemed the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, and cursed. And they brought him unto Moses: (and his mother's **Name** was Shelomith, the daughter of Dibri, of the tribe of Dan:)”

**Leviticus 24:16** – “And he that blasphemeth the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, he shall surely be put to death, and all the congregation shall certainly stone him: as well the stranger, as he that is born in the land, when he blasphemeth the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, shall be put to death.”

**Numbers 6:27** – “And they shall **put my Name** upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.”

**Deut. 5:11** – “You shall not take the **Name** of the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** in vain: for the **Yehovah** will not hold him guiltless that takes his **Name** in vain.”

**Deut. 6:13** - You shall fear the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, and serve him, and shall swear by his **Name**.”

**Deut. 10:8** – “At that time the **Yehovah** separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the Ark of the Covenant of the **Yehovah**, to stand before the **Yehovah** to minister unto him, and to bless in his **Name**, unto this day.”

**Deut. 10:20** – “You shall fear the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**; him shall you serve, and to him shall you cleave, and swear by his **Name**.”

**Deut.12:5** – “But unto the place which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** shall choose out of all your tribes to put his **Name** there, even unto his habitation shall you seek, and there you shall come:”

**Deut. 12:11** – “Then there shall be a place which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** shall choose to cause his **Name** to dwell there; there shall you bring all that I command you; your burnt offerings, and your sacrifices, your tithes, and the heave offering of your hand, and all your choice vows which you vow unto the **Yehovah**:”

**Deut. 12:21** – “If the place which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** has chosen to put his **Name** there be too far from you, then you shall kill of your herd and of your flock, which the **Yehovah** has given you, as I have commanded you, and you shall eat in your gates whatsoever your soul lusts after.”

**Deut. 14:23** – “And you shall eat before the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, in the place which he shall choose to place his **Name** there, the tithe of your corn, of your wine, and of your oil, and the firstlings of your herds and of your flocks; that you may learn to fear the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** always.”

**Deut. 14:24** – “And if the way be too long for you, so that you are not able to carry it; or if the place be too far from you, which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** shall choose to set his **Name** there, when the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** has blessed you:”

**Deut. 16:2** – “You shall therefore sacrifice the Passover unto the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, of the flock and the herd, in the place which the **Yehovah** shall choose to place his **Name** there.”

**Deut. 16:6** – “But at the place which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** shall choose to place his **Name** in, there you shall sacrifice the Passover at even, at the going down of the sun, at the season that you came forth out of Egypt.”

**Deut. 16:11** – “And you shall rejoice before the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite that is within your gates, and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are among you, in the place which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** has chosen to place his **Name** there.”

**Deut. 18:5** – “For the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** has chosen him out of all your tribes, to stand to minister in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, him and his sons for ever.”

**Deut. 18:7** – “Then he shall minister in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** his **Elohim**, as all his brethren the Levites do, which stand there before the **Yehovah**.”

**Deut. 18:19** – “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my **Name**, I will require it of him.”

**Deut. 18:20** – “But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my **Name**, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other Elohim, even that prophet shall die.”

**Deut. 18:22** – “When a prophet speaks in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the **Yehovah** has not spoken, but the prophet has spoken it presumptuously: you shall not be afraid of him.”

**Deut. 21:5** – “And the priests the sons of Levi shall come near; for them the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** has chosen to minister unto him, and to bless in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**; and by their word shall every controversy and every stroke be tried:”

Deut. 26:2 – “That you shall take of the first of all the fruit of the Earth, which you shall bring of your land that the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** gives you, and shall put it in a basket, and shall go unto the place which the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** shall choose to place his **Name** there.”

Deut. 26:19 – “And to make you high above all nations which he has made, in praise, and in name, and in honour; and that you may be a holy people unto the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, as he has spoken.”

Deut. 28:10 – “And all people of the Earth shall see that you are called by the **Name** of the **Yehovah**; and they shall be afraid of you.”

Deut. 28:58 – “If you will not observe to do all the words of this Law that are written in this book, that you may fear this glorious and fearful **Name**, The **Yehovah** your **Elohim**;”

Deut. 32:3 – “Because I will publish the **Name** of the **Yehovah**: ascribe you greatness unto our **Elohim**.”

Joshua 9:9 – “And they said unto him, From a very far country your servants are come because of the **Name** of the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**: for we have heard the fame of him, and all that he did in Egypt,”

I Samuel 7:12 – “Then Samuel took a stone, and set it between Mizpeh and Shen, and called the name of it Eben-ezer, saying, Hitherto has the **Yehovah** helped us.”

I Samuel 12:22 – “For the **Yehovah** will not forsake his people for his great Name's sake: because it has pleased the **Yehovah** to make you his people.”

I Samuel 17:45 – “Then said David to the Philistine, You come to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to you in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** of Hosts, the **Elohim** of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.”

I Samuel 20:42 – “And Jonathan said to David, Go in peace, forasmuch as we have sworn both of us in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, saying, The **Yehovah** be between me and you, and between my seed and your seed forever. And he arose and departed: and Jonathan went into the city.”

II Samuel 6:2 – “And David arose, and went with all the people that were with him from Baale of Judah, to bring up from there the Ark of **Elohim**, whose **Name** is called by the **Name** of the **Yehovah** of Hosts that dwells between the Cherubims.”

II Samuel 6:18 – “And as soon as David had made an end of offering burnt offerings and peace offerings, he blessed the people in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** of Hosts.”

II Samuel 7:13 – “He shall build a house for my **Name**, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever.”

**II Samuel 7:23** - “And what one nation in the Earth is like your people, even like Israel, whom **Elohim** went to redeem for a people to himself, and to make him a **Name**, and to do for you great things and terrible, for your land, before your people, which you redeemed to you from Egypt, from the nations and their Elohim?”

**II Samuel 7:26** - “And let your **Name** be magnified forever, saying, The **Yehovah** of Hosts is the **Elohim** over Israel: and let the house of your servant David be established before you.”

**II Samuel 22:50** - “Therefore I will give thanks unto you, O **Yehovah**, among the heathen, and I will sing praises unto your **Name**.”

**I Kings 3:2** - “Only the people sacrificed in high places, because there was no house built unto the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, until those days.”

**I Kings 5:3** - “You know how that David my father could not build a house unto the **Name** of the **Yehovah** his **Elohim** for the wars which were about him on every side, until the **Yehovah** put them under the soles of his feet.”

**I Kings 5:5** - “And, behold, I purpose to build a house unto the **Name** of the **Yehovah** my **Elohim**, as the **Yehovah** spoke unto David my father, saying, Your son, whom I will set upon your throne in your room, he shall build a house unto my **Name**.”

**I Kings 8:16-20** - “Since the day that I brought forth my people Israel out of Egypt, I chose no city out of all the tribes of Israel to build a house, that my **Name** might be therein; but I chose David to be over my people Israel. And it was in the heart of David my father to build a house for the **Name** of the **Yehovah Elohim** of Israel. And the **Yehovah** said unto David my father, Whereas it was in your heart to build a house unto my **Name**, you did well that it was in your heart. Nevertheless you shall not build the house; but your son that shall come forth out of your loins, he shall build the house unto my **Name**. And the **Yehovah** has performed his word that he spoke, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the **Yehovah** promised, and have built a house for the **Name** of the **Yehovah Elohim** of Israel.”

**I Kings 8:29** - “That your eyes may be open toward this house night and day, even toward the place of which you hast said, My **Name** shall be there: that you may hearken unto the Prayer which your servant shall make toward this place.”

**I Kings 8:33** - “When your people Israel be smitten down before the enemy, because they have sinned against you, and shall turn again to you, and **confess your Name**, and pray, and make supplication unto you in this house:”

**I Kings 8:35** - “When Heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against you; if they pray toward this place, and **confess your Name**, and turn from their sin, when you afflicted them:”

**I Kings 8:41-44** - “Moreover concerning a stranger, that is not of your people Israel, but comes out of a far country **for your Name's sake**; (For they shall hear of your great **Name**, and of your strong hand, and of your stretched out arm;) when he shall come and pray toward this house; Hear you in Heaven your dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calls to you for: **that all people of the Earth may know your Name**, to fear you, as do your people Israel; and that they may know that this house, which I have builded, is called by **your Name**. If your people go out to battle against their enemy, whithersoever you shall send them, and shall pray unto the **Yehovah** toward the city which you have chosen, and toward the house that I have built for **your Name**.”

**I Kings 8:48** - “And so return **unto You** with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray **unto You** toward their land, which you gave unto their fathers, the city which you have chosen, and the house which I have built for **your Name**.”

**I Kings 9:3** - “And the **Yehovah** said unto him, I have heard your Prayer and your supplication, that you have made before me: I have hallowed this house, which you have built, to put **my Name** there forever; and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually.”

**I Kings 9:7** - “Then will I cut off Israel out of the land which I have given them; and this house, which I have hallowed for **my Name**, will I cast out of my sight; and Israel shall be a proverb and a byword among all people:”

**I Kings 10:1** - “And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, she came to prove him with hard questions.”

**I Kings 14:21** - “And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Rehoboam was forty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the **city which the Yehovah** did choose out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his **Name** there. And his mother's name was Naamah an Ammonitess.”

**I Kings 18:24-26** - “And call you on the name of your Elohim, and **I will call on the Name of the Yehovah**: and the **Elohim** that answers by fire, let him be **Elohim**. And all the people answered and said, It is well spoken. And Elijah said unto the prophets of Baal, Choose you one bullock for yourselves, and dress it first; for you are many; and call on the name of your Elohim, but put no fire under. And they took the bullock which was given them, and they dressed it, and called on the name of Baal from morning even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But there was no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made.”

**I Kings 18:31** - “And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, unto whom the word of the **Yehovah** came, saying, Israel shall be your name:

**I Kings 18:32** - “And with the stones he built an altar in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**: and he made a trench about the altar, as great as would contain two measures of seed.”

**I Kings 18:36-39** - “ And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, **Yehovah Elohim** of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known **this day** that **You are Elohim in Israel**, and that I am your servant, and that I have done all these things at **your word**. Hear me, **O Yehovah**, hear me, **that this people may know that You are the Yehovah Elohim**, and that You have turned their heart back again. Then the fire of the **Yehovah** fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, **The Yehovah, He is the Elohim; the Yehovah, He is the Elohim.**”

**I Kings 22:16** - “And the king said unto him, How many times shall I adjure you that you tell me nothing but that which is true in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**?”

**II Kings 2:24** - “And he turned back, and looked on them, and cursed them in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**. And there came forth two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them.”

**II Kings 5:11** - “But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, he will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the **Name** of the **Yehovah** his **Elohim**, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper.”

**II Kings 21:4** - “And he built altars in the house of the **Yehovah**, of which the **Yehovah** said, In Jerusalem will I put my **Name**.”

**II Kings 21:7** - “And he set a graven image of the grove that he had made in the house, of which the **Yehovah** said to David, and to Solomon his son, In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen out of all tribes of Israel, will I put my **Name** forever:.”

**I Chronicles 13:6** - “And David went up, and all Israel, to Baalah, that is, to Kirjath-jearim, which belonged to Judah, to bring up there the Ark of **Elohim** the **Yehovah**, that dwells between the cherubims, whose **Name** is called on it.”

**I Chronicles 16:2** - “And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**.”

**I Chronicles 16:8** - “Give thanks unto the **Yehovah**, call upon his **Name**, make known his deeds among the people.”

**I Chronicle 16:10** - “Glory you in his holy **Name**: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the **Yehovah**.”

**I Chronicles 16:29** - “Give unto the **Yehovah** the glory due unto his **Name**: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the **Yehovah** in the beauty of holiness.”

**I Chronicles 16:35** - “And say you, Save us, **O Elohim** of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to your holy **Name**, and glory in your praise.”

**I Chronicle 17:21** – “And what one nation in the Earth is like your people Israel, whom **Elohim** went to redeem to be his own people, to make you a **Name** of greatness and terribleness, by driving out nations from before your people, whom you have redeemed out of Egypt?”

**I Chronicle 17:24** – “Let it even be established, that your **Name** may be magnified forever, saying, The **Yehovah** of Hosts is the **Elohim** of Israel, even a **Elohim** to Israel: and let the house of David your servant be established before you.”

**I Chronicles 21:19** – “And David went up at the saying of Gad, which he spoke in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**.”

**I Chronicles 22:7** – “And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build a house unto the **Name** of the **Yehovah** my **Elohim**.”

**I Chronicles 22:8** – “But the word of the **Yehovah** came to me, saying, You have shed blood abundantly, and have made great wars: you shall not build a house unto my **Name**, because you have shed much blood upon the Earth in my sight.”

**I Chronicles 22:10** – “He shall build a house for my **Name**; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel forever.”

**I Chronicles 22:19** – “Now set your heart and your soul to seek the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**; arise therefore, and build you the sanctuary of the **Yehovah Elohim**, to bring the Ark of the Covenant of the **Yehovah**, and the holy vessels of **Elohim**, into the house that is to be built to the **Name** of the **Yehovah**.”

**I Chronicles 23:13** – “The sons of Amram; Aaron and Moses: and Aaron was separated, that he should sanctify the most holy things, he and his sons forever, to burn incense before the **Yehovah**, to minister unto him, and to bless in his **Name** forever.”

**I Chronicles 28:3** – “But **Elohim** said unto me, You shall not build a house for my **Name**, because you have been a man of war, and have shed blood.”

**I Chronicles 29:13** – “Now therefore, our **Elohim**, we thank you, and praise your glorious **Name**.”

**I Chronicles 29:16** – “O **Yehovah** our **Elohim**, all this store that we have prepared to build you a house for your holy **Name** comes of your hand, and is all your own.”

**II Chronicles 2:1** – “And Solomon determined to build a house for the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, and a house for his kingdom.”

**II Chronicles 2:4** – “Behold, I build a house to the **Name** of the **Yehovah** my **Elohim**, to dedicate it to him, and to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual shewbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the Shabbats, and on the New Moons, and on the solemn feasts of the **Yehovah** our **Elohim**. This is an ordinance forever to Israel.”

**II Chronicles 6:5-10** - “Since the day that I brought forth my people out of the land of Egypt I chose no city among all the tribes of Israel to build a house in, that my **Name** might be there; neither chose I any man to be a ruler over my people Israel: But I have chosen Jerusalem, that my **Name** might be there; and have chosen David to be over my people Israel. Now it was in the heart of David my father to build a house for the **Name** of the **Yehovah Elohim** of Israel. But the **Yehovah** said to David my father, Forasmuch as it was in your heart to build a house for my **Name**, you did well in that it was in your heart: Notwithstanding you shall not build the house; but your son which shall come forth out of your loins, he shall build the house for my **Name**. The **Yehovah** therefore has performed his word that he has spoken: for I am risen up in the room of David my father, and am set on the throne of Israel, as the **Yehovah** promised, and have built the house for the **Name** of the **Yehovah Elohim** of Israel.”

**II Chronicles 6:20** - “That your eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place whereof you have said that you would put your **Name** there; to hearken unto the Prayer which your servant prays toward this place.”

**II Chronicles 6:24-39** - “And if your people Israel be put to the worse before the enemy, because they have sinned against you; and shall return and **Confess your Name**, and Pray and make Supplication before you in this house; **Then hear You** from the Heavens, and forgive the sin of your people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which you gave to them and to their fathers. When the Heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against you; yet if they Pray toward this place, and **Confess your Name**, and turn from their sin, when you do afflict them; **Then hear You** from Heaven, and forgive the sin of your servants, and of your people Israel, when you have taught them the good way, wherein they should walk; and send rain upon your land, which you have given unto your people for an inheritance. If there be dearth in the land, if there be pestilence, if there be blasting, or mildew, locusts, or caterpillers; if their enemies besiege them in the cities of their land; whatsoever sore or whatsoever sickness there be: Then what Prayer or what Supplication soever shall be made of any man, or of all your people Israel, when every one shall know his own sore and his own grief, and shall spread forth his hands in this house: **Then hear You** from Heaven your dwelling place, and forgive, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart you know; (for You only know the hearts of the children of men:) That they may fear You, to walk in your ways, so long as they live in the land which you gave unto our fathers. Moreover concerning the stranger, which is not of your people Israel, but is come from a far country for your great **Name's** sake, and your mighty hand, and your stretched out arm; if they come and Pray in this house; **Then hear You** from the Heavens, even from your dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calls to you for; **that ALL people of the Earth may know your Name**, and fear You, as do your people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by your **Name**. If your people go out to war against their enemies by the way that you shall send them, and they Pray unto you toward this city which you have chosen, and the house which I have built for your **Name**; **Then hear You** from the Heavens their Prayer and their Supplication, and maintain their cause. If they sin against you, (for there is no man which sins not,) and you be angry with them, and deliver them over before their enemies, and they carry them away captives unto a land far off or near; Yet if they bethink themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and Pray unto you in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly; If they

return to you with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, whither they have carried them captives, and Pray toward their land, which you gave unto their fathers, and toward the city which you have chosen, and toward the house which I have built for your **Name**: Then hear You from the Heavens, even from your dwelling place, their Prayer and their Supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive your people which have sinned against you.”

II Chronicles 7:14 - “If my people, which are called by my Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from Heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.”

II Chronicles 7:16 - “For now have I chosen and sanctified this house, that my **Name** may be there forever: and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually.”

II Chronicles 7:20 - “Then will I pluck them up by the roots out of my land which I have given them; and this house, which I have sanctified for my **Name**, will I cast out of my sight, and will make it to be a proverb and a byword among all nations.”

II Chronicles 12:13 - “So king Rehoboam strengthened himself in Jerusalem, and reigned: for Rehoboam was one and forty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the **Yehovah** had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his **Name** there. And his mother's name was Naamah an Ammonitess.”

II Chronicles 14:11 - “And Asa cried unto the **Yehovah** his **Elohim**, and said, **Yehovah**, it is nothing with you to help, whether with many, or with them that have no power: help us, O **Yehovah** our **Elohim**; for we rest on you, and in your Name we go against this multitude. O **Yehovah**, you are our **Elohim**; let not man prevail against you.”

II Chronicles 18:15 - “And the king said to him, How many times shall I adjure you that you say nothing but the truth to me in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**?”

II Chronicles 20:8-9 - “And they dwelled therein, and have built you a sanctuary therein for your **Name**, saying, If, when evil comes upon us, as the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we stand before this house, and in your presence, (for your **Name** is in this house,) and cry unto you in our affliction, then you will hear and help.”

II Chronicles 20:26 - “And on the fourth day they assembled themselves in the valley of Berachah; for there they blessed the **Yehovah**: therefore the name of the same place was called, The valley of Berachah, unto this day.”

II Chronicles 33:4 - “Also he built altars in the house of the **Yehovah**, whereof the **Yehovah** had said, In Jerusalem shall my Name be forever.”

II Chronicles 33:7 - “And he set a carved image, the idol which he had made, in the house of **Elohim**, of which **Elohim** had said to David and to Solomon his son, In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen before all the tribes of Israel, will I put my Name forever.”

**II Chronicles 33:18** - “Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his Prayer unto his **Elohim**, and the words of the seers that spoke to him **in the Name of the Yehovah Elohim of Israel**, behold, they are written in the book of the kings of Israel.”

**Ezra 5:1** - “Then the prophets, Haggai the prophet, and Zechariah the son of Iddo, prophesied unto the Jews that were in Judah and Jerusalem **in the Name of the Elohim of Israel**, even unto them.”

**Ezra 6:12** - “And the **Elohim** that has caused his **Name** to dwell there destroy all kings and people, that shall put to their hand to alter and to destroy this house of **Elohim** which is at Jerusalem. I Darius have made a decree; let it be done with speed.”

**Nehemiah 1:9** - “But if you turn unto me, and keep my Commandments, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the Heaven, yet will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that **I have chosen to set my Name there.**”

**Nehemiah 1:11** - “O **Yehovah**, I beseech you, let now your ear be attentive to the Prayer of your servant, and to the Prayer of your servants, who desire to fear your **Name**: and prosper, I pray you, your servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer.”

**Nehemiah 9:5** - “Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah, said, Stand up and bless the **Yehovah** your **Elohim** forever and ever: and **blessed be your glorious Name**, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.”

**Nehemiah 9:10** - “And shew signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for you knew that they dealt proudly against them. So did you get you a **Name**, as it is this day.”

**Psalms 5:11** - “But let all those that put their trust in you rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because you defend them: let them also that **love your Name** be joyful in you.”

**Psalms 7:17** - “I will praise the **Yehovah** according to his righteousness: and will sing praise to the **Name** of the **Yehovah** most high.”

**Psalms 8:1** - “O **Yehovah**, our **Yehovah**, **how excellent is your Name in all the Earth!** who have set your glory above the Heavens.”

**Psalms 8:9** - “O **Yehovah**, our **Yehovah**, **how excellent is your Name in all the Earth!**”

**Psalms 9:2** - “I will be glad and rejoice in you: I will sing praise to your **Name**, O you most High.”

**Psalms 9:10** - “And **they that know your Name** will put their trust in you: for you, **Yehovah**, have not forsaken them that seek you.”

Psalm 18:49 - “Therefore will I give thanks unto you, O **Yehovah**, among the heathen, and sing praises unto your Name.”

Psalm 20:1 - “The **Yehovah** hear you in the day of trouble; the **Name** of the **Elohim** of Jacob defends you;”

Psalm 20:5 - “We will rejoice in your salvation, and in the **Name** of our **Elohim** we will set up our banners: the **Yehovah** fulfil all your petitions.”

Psalm 20:7 - “Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the Name of the Yehovah our Elohim.”

Psalm 22:22 - “I will declare your **Name** unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise you.”

Psalm 23:3 - “He restores my soul: he leads me in the paths of righteousness for his **Name's** sake.”

Psalm 25:11 - “For your **Name's** sake, O **Yehovah**, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great.

Psalm 29:2 - “Give unto the **Yehovah** the glory due unto his **Name**; worship the **Yehovah** in the beauty of holiness.”

Psalm 31:3 - “For you are my Rock and my fortress; therefore for your **Name's** sake lead me, and guide me.”

Psalm 33:21 - “For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy Name.”

Psalm 34:3 - “O magnify the **Yehovah** with me, and let us exalt his Name together.”

Psalm 44:5 - “Through you will we push down our enemies: through your Name will we tread them under that rise up against us.”

Psalm 44:8 - “In **Elohim** we boast all the day long, and praise your **Name** forever. Selah.”

Psalm 44:20-21 - “If we have forgotten the **Name** of our **Elohim**, or stretched out our hands to a strange Elohim;” Shall not **Elohim** search this out? for he knows the secrets of the heart.

Psalm 45:17 - “I will make your **Name** to be remembered in all generations: therefore shall the people praise you forever and ever.”

Psalm 48:10 - “According to your **Name**, O **Elohim**, so is your praise unto the ends of the Earth: your right hand is full of righteousness.”

Psalm 52:9 - “I will praise you forever, because you have done it: and I will wait on your **Name**; for it is good before your saints.”

Psalm 54:1 - "Save me, O **Elohim**, by your **Name**, and judge me by your strength."

Psalm 54:6 - "I will freely sacrifice unto you: I will praise your **Name**, O **Yehovah**; for it is good."

Psalm 61:5 - "For you, O **Elohim**, have heard my vows: you have given me the heritage of those that fear your **Name**."

Psalm 61:8 - "So will I sing praise unto your **Name** forever, that I may daily perform my vows."

Psalm 63:4 - "Thus will I bless you while I live: I will lift up my hands in your **Name**."

Psalm 66:2 - "Sing forth the honour of his **Name**: make his praise glorious."

Psalm 66:4 - "All the Earth shall worship you, and shall sing unto you; they shall sing to your **Name**. Selah."

Psalm 68:4 - "Sing unto **Elohim**, sing praises to his **Name**: extol him that rides upon the Heavens by his **Name Yeho**, and rejoice before him."

Psalm 69:30 - "I will praise the **Name** of **Elohim** with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving."

Psalm 69:33-36 - "For the **Yehovah** hears the poor, and despises not his prisoners. Let the Heaven and Earth praise him, the seas, and everything that moves therein. For **Elohim** will save Zion, and will build the cities of Judah: that they may dwell there, and have it in possession. The seed also of his servants shall inherit it: and they that love his **Name** shall dwell therein."

Psalm 72:17-19 - "His **Name** shall endure forever: his **Name** shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed. Blessed be the **Yehovah Elohim**, the **Elohim** of Israel, who only does wondrous things. And blessed be his glorious **Name** forever: and let the whole Earth be filled with his glory; Amen, and Amen."

Psalm 74:21 - "O let not the oppressed return ashamed: let the poor and needy praise your **Name**."

Psalm 75:1 - "Unto you, O **Elohim**, do we give thanks, unto you do we give thanks: for that your **Name** is near your wondrous works declare."

Psalm 76:1 - "In Judah is **Elohim** known: his **Name** is great in Israel."

Psalm 79:6 - "Pour out your wrath upon the heathen that have not known you, and upon the kingdoms that have not called upon your **Name**."

Psalm 79:9 - "Help us, O **Elohim** of our salvation, for the glory of your **Name**: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for your **Name's** sake."

Psalm 80:18 - “So will not we go back from you: quicken us, and we will call upon your **Name.**”

Psalm 83:16 - “Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek your **Name, O Yehovah.**”

Psalm 83:18 - “That men may know that you, whose **Name** alone is **Yehovah**, are the Most High over all the Earth.”

Psalm 86:9 - “All nations whom you have made shall come and worship before you, O **Yehovah**; and shall glorify your **Name.**”

Psalm 86:11-12 - “Teach me your way, O **Yehovah**; I will walk in your truth: unite my heart to fear your **Name**. I will praise you, O **Yehovah** my **Elohim**, with all my heart: and I will glorify your **Name** for evermore.”

Psalm 89:12 - “The north and the south you have created them: Tabor and Hermon shall rejoice in your **Name.**”

Psalm 89:16 - “In your **Name** shall they rejoice all the day: and in your righteousness shall they be exalted.”

Psalm 89:24 - “But my faithfulness and my mercy shall be with him: and in my **Name** shall his horn be exalted.”

Psalm 91:14 - “Because he has set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known my **Name.**”

Psalm 92:1-2 - “It is a good thing to give thanks unto the **Yehovah**, and to sing praises unto your **Name**, O most High: Sing unto the **Yehovah**, bless his **Name**; shew forth his salvation from day to day.”

Psalm 96:8 - “Give unto the **Yehovah** the glory due unto his **Name**: bring an offering, and come into his courts.”

Psalm 99:3 - “Let them praise your great and terrible **Name**; for it is holy.”

Psalm 99:6 - “Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his **Name**; they called upon the **Yehovah**, and he answered them.”

Psalm 100:4 - “Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his **Name.**”

Psalm 102:15 - “So the heathen shall fear the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, and all the kings of the Earth your glory.”

Psalm 102:21 - “To declare the **Name** of the **Yehovah** in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem;”

Psalm 103:1 - “Bless the **Yehovah**, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy **Name**.”

Psalm 105:1 - “O give thanks unto the **Yehovah**; call upon his **Name**: make known his deeds among the people.”

Psalm 105:3 - “Glory you in his holy **Name**: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the **Yehovah**.”

Psalm 106:8 - “Nevertheless he saved them for his **Name's** sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known.”

Psalm 106:47 - “Save us, O **Yehovah** our **Elohim**, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto your holy **Name**, and to triumph in your praise.”

Psalm 109:21 - “But do you for me, O **Elohim** the **Yehovah**, for your **Name's** sake: because your mercy is good, deliver you me.”

Psalm 111:9 - “He sent redemption unto his people: he has commanded his Covenant for ever: holy and reverend is his **Name**.”

Psalm 113:1-3 - “Praise you the **Yehovah**. Praise, O you servants of the **Yehovah**, praise the **Name** of the **Yehovah**. Psalm 115:1 - “Not unto us, O **Yehovah**, not unto us, but unto your **Name** give glory, for your mercy, and for your truth's sake.”

Psalm 116:4 - “Then called I upon the **Name** of the **Yehovah**; O **Yehovah**, I beseech you, deliver my soul.”

Psalm 116:13 - “I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the **Name** of the **Yehovah**.”

Psalm 116:17 - “I will offer to you the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the **Name** of the **Yehovah**.”

Psalm 118:10 - “All nations compassed me about: but in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** will I destroy them.”

Psalm 118:11-12 - “They compassed me about; yea, they compassed me about: but in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** I will destroy them. They compassed me about like bees; they are quenched as the fire of thorns: for in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** I will destroy them.”

Psalm 118:26 - “Blessed be he that comes in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**: we have blessed you out of the house of the **Yehovah**.”

Psalm 124:8 - “Our help is in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, who made Heaven and Earth.”

Psalm 135:3 - “Praise the **Yehovah**; for the **Yehovah** is good: sing praises unto his **Name**; for it is pleasant.”

Psalm 135:13 - “Your **Name**, O **Yehovah**, endures forever; and your memorial, O **Yehovah**, throughout all generations.”

Psalm 138:2 - “I will worship toward your holy temple, and praise your **Name** for your lovingkindness and for your truth: for you have magnified your word above all your **Name**.”

Psalm 140:13 - “Surely the righteous shall give thanks unto your **Name**: the upright shall dwell in your presence.”

Psalm 142:7 - “Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise your **Name**: the righteous shall compass me about; for you shall deal bountifully with me.”

Psalm 143:11 - “Quicken me, O **Yehovah**, for your **Name**'s sake: for your righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble.”

Psalm 145:1-2 - “I will extol you, my **Elohim**, O King; and I will bless your **Name** forever and ever. Every day will I bless you; and I will praise your **Name** forever and ever.”

Psalm 145:21 - “My mouth shall speak the praise of the **Yehovah**: and let all flesh bless his holy **Name** forever and ever.”

Psalm 148:5 - “Let them praise the **Name** of the **Yehovah**: for he commanded, and they were created.”

Psalm 148:13 - “Let them praise the **Name** of the **Yehovah**: for his **Name** alone is excellent; his glory is above the Earth and Heaven.”

**Psalm 149:3** - “Let them praise his **Name** in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.”

**Proverbs 18:10** - “The **Name** of the **Yehovah** is a strong tower: the righteous runs into it, and is safe.”

**Isaiah 12:4** - “And in that day shall you say, Praise the **Yehovah**, call upon his **Name**, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his **Name** is exalted.”

**Isaiah 18:7** - “In that time shall the present be brought unto the **Yehovah** of Hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the **Name** of the **Yehovah** of Hosts, the mount Zion.”

**Isaiah 24:15** - “Wherefore glorify you the **Yehovah** in the fires, even the **Name** of the **Yehovah Elohim** of Israel in the isles of the sea.”

**Isaiah 25:1** - “O **Yehovah**, you are my Elohim; I will exalt you, I will praise your **Name**; for you have done wonderful things; your counsels of old are faithfulness and truth.”

**Isaiah 26:8** - “Yea, in the way of your judgments, O **Yehovah**, have we waited for you; the desire of our soul is to your **Name**, and to the remembrance of you.”

**Isaiah 29:22-23** - “Therefore thus says the **Yehovah**, who redeemed Abraham, concerning the house of Jacob, Jacob shall not now be ashamed, neither shall his face now wax pale. But when he sees his children, the work of mine hands, in the midst of him, they shall sanctify my **Name**, and sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and shall fear the **Elohim** of Israel.”

**Isaiah 30:27** - “Behold, the **Name** of the **Yehovah** comes from far, burning with his anger, and the burden thereof is heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire:”

**Isaiah 41:25** - “I have raised up one from the north, and he shall come: from the rising of the Sun shall he **call upon my Name**: and he shall come upon princes as upon mortar, and as the potter treads clay.”

**Isaiah 42:8** - “I am the **Yehovah**: that is my **Name**: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.”

**Isaiah 43:1** - “But now thus says the **Yehovah** that created you, O Jacob, and he that formed you, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed you, I have called you by your **Name**; you are mine.”

**Isaiah 43:7** - “Even every one that is called by my **Name**: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.”

**Isaiah 44:5** - “One shall say, I am the **Yehovah**'s; and another shall call himself by the name of Jacob; and another shall subscribe with his hand unto the **Yehovah**, and surname himself by the name of Israel.”

**Isaiah 45:3-4** - “And I will give you the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that you may know that I, the **Yehovah**, which call you by your **Name**, am the **Elohim** of Israel. For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called you by your name: I have surnamed you, though you have not known me.”

**Isaiah 47:4** - “As for our redeemer, the **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**, the Holy One of Israel.”

**Isaiah 48:1-2** - “Hear you this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, and make mention of the **Elohim** of Israel, but not in truth, nor in righteousness. For they call themselves of the holy city, and stay themselves upon the **Elohim** of Israel; The **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**.”

**Isaiah 48:9** - “For my **Name**'s sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for you, that I cut you not off.

**Isaiah 50:10** - “Who is among you that fears the **Yehovah**, that obeys the voice of his servant, that walks in darkness, and has no light? let him trust in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, and stay upon his **Elohim**.”

**Isaiah 51:15** - “But I am the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**.”

**Isaiah 52:6** - “Therefore **my people shall know my Name**: therefore they shall know in that day that I am he that does speak: behold, it is I.”

**Isaiah 54:5** - “For your Maker is your husband; the **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**; and your Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The **Elohim** of the whole Earth shall he be called.”

**Isaiah 55:13** - “Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir tree, and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree: and it shall be to the **Yehovah** for a **Name**, for an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off.”

**Isaiah 56:5-6** - “Even unto them will I give in mine house and within my walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off. Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the **Yehovah**, **to serve him, and to love the Name of the Yehovah**, to be his servants, every one that keeps the Shabbat from polluting it, and takes hold of my Covenant;”

**Isaiah 57:15** - “For thus says the high and lofty One that inhabits eternity, whose **Name** is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.”

**Isaiah 59:19** - “So shall they fear the **Name** of the **Yehovah** from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the **Yehovah** shall lift up a standard against him.”

**Isaiah 60:9** - “Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring your sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the **Name** of the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he has glorified you.”

**Isaiah 63:12** - “That led them by the right hand of Moses with his glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make himself an everlasting **Name**?”

**Isaiah 63:14** - “As a beast goes down into the valley, the Spirit of the **Yehovah** caused him to rest: so did you lead your people, to make yourself a glorious **Name**.”

**Isaiah 63:16** - “Doubtless you are our father, though Abraham be ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: You, O **Yehovah**, are our father, our redeemer; your **Name** is from everlasting.”

**Isaiah 63:19** - “We are your: you never bare rule over them; they were not called by your name.”

**Isaiah 64:2** - “As when the melting fire burns, the fire causes the waters to boil, to make your **Name** known to your adversaries, that the nations may tremble at your presence!”

**Isaiah 66:5** - “Hear the word of the **Yehovah**, you that tremble at his word; your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my **Name**'s sake, said, Let the **Yehovah** be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed.”

**Jeremiah 3:17** - “At that time they shall call Jerusalem the throne of the **Yehovah**; and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, to Jerusalem: neither shall they walk any more after the imagination of their evil heart.”

**Jeremiah 10:6** - “Forasmuch as there is none like unto you, O **Yehovah**; you are great, and your **Name** is great in might.”

**Jeremiah 10:16** - “The portion of Jacob is not like them: for he is the former of all things; and Israel is the rod of his inheritance: The **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**.”

**Jeremiah 10:25** - “Pour out your fury upon the heathen that know you not, and upon the families that call not on your **Name**: for they have eaten up Jacob, and devoured him, and consumed him, and have made his habitation desolate.”

**Jeremiah 11:21** - “Therefore thus says the **Yehovah** of the men of Anathoth, that seek your life, saying, Prophesy not in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, that you die not by our hand:”

**Jeremiah 12:16** - “And it shall come to pass, if they will diligently learn the ways of my people, to swear by my **Name**, The **Yehovah** lives; as they taught my people to swear by Baal; then shall they be built in the midst of my people.”

**Jeremiah 14:7** - “O **Yehovah**, though our iniquities testify against us, do you it for your **Name's** sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against you.”

**Jeremiah 14:9** - “Why should you be as a man astonished, as a mighty man that cannot save? yet you, O **Yehovah**, are in the midst of us, and we are called by your **Name**; leave us not.”

**Jeremiah 14:21** - “Do not abhor us, for your **Name's** sake, do not disgrace the throne of your glory: remember, break not your Covenant with us.”

**Jeremiah 15:16** - “Your words were found, and I did eat them; and your word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by your **Name**, O **Yehovah Elohim** of Hosts.”

**Jeremiah 16:21** - “Therefore, behold, I will this once cause them to know, I will cause them to know mine hand and my might; and they shall know that my **Name** is The **Yehovah**.”

**Jeremiah 20:9** - “Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his **Name**. But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not stay.”

**Jeremiah 23:6** - “In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his **Name** whereby he shall be called, The **Yehovah** our Righteousness.”

**Jeremiah 26:16** - “Then said the princes and all the people unto the priests and to the prophets; This man is not worthy to die: for he has spoken to us in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** our **Elohim**.”

**Jeremiah 26:20** - “And there was also a man that prophesied in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**, Urijah the son of Shemaiah of Kirjath-jearim, who prophesied against this city and against this land according to all the words of Jeremiah:”

**Jeremiah 31:35** - “Thus says the **Yehovah**, which gives the Sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the Moon and of the stars for a light by night, which divides the sea when the waves thereof roar; The **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**:”

**Jeremiah 32:18** - “You shew lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompense the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty **Elohim**, the **Yehovah** of Hosts, is his **Name**,”

**Jeremiah 32:20** - “Which have set signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, even unto this day, and in Israel, and among other men; and have made you a **Name**, as at this day;”

**Jeremiah 33:2** - “Thus says the **Yehovah** the maker thereof, the **Yehovah** that formed it, to establish it; the **Yehovah** is his **Name**;”

**Jeremiah 33:16** - “In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the **Name** wherewith she shall be called, The **Yehovah** our righteousness.”

**Jeremiah 34:15** - “And you were now turned, and had done right in my sight, in proclaiming liberty every man to his neighbour; and you had made a Covenant before me in the house which is called by my **Name**.”

**Jeremiah 46:18** - “As I live, says the King, whose **Name** is the **Yehovah** of Hosts, Surely as Tabor is among the mountains, and as Carmel by the sea, so shall he come.”

**Jeremiah 48:15** - “Moab is spoiled, and gone up out of her cities, and his chosen young men are gone down to the slaughter, saith the King, whose **Name** is the **Yehovah** of Hosts.”

**Jeremiah 50:34** - “Their Redeemer is strong; the **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.”

**Jeremiah 51:19** - “The portion of Jacob is not like them; for he is the former of all things: and Israel is the rod of his inheritance: the **Yehovah** of Hosts is his **Name**.”

**Ezekiel 20:14** - “But I wrought for my **Name's** sake, that it should not be polluted before the heathen, in whose sight I brought them out.”

**Ezekiel 20:22** - “Nevertheless I withdrew mine hand, and wrought for my **Name's** sake, that it should not be polluted in the sight of the heathen, in whose sight I brought them forth.”

**Ezekiel 20:44** - “And you shall know that I am the **Yehovah**, when I have wrought with you for my **Name's** sake, not according to your wicked ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, O you house of Israel, saith the **Yehovah Elohim**.”

**Ezekiel 36:21-23** - “But I had pity for mine holy **Name**, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went. Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus says the **Yehovah Elohim**; I do not this for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy **Name's** sake, which you have profaned among the heathen, whither you went. And I will sanctify my great **Name**, which was profaned among the heathen, which you have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am the **Yehovah**, says the **Yehovah Elohim**, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes.”

**Ezekiel 39:7** - “So will **I make my Holy Name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my Holy Name any more**: and the heathen shall know that I am the **Yehovah**, the Holy One in Israel.”

**Ezekiel 39:25** - “Therefore thus says the **Yehovah Elohim**; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy **Name**;”

**Ezekiel 43:7** - “And he said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever, and my holy **Name**, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places.”

Ezekiel 48:35 - “It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, **The Yehovah is there.**”

Daniel 2:20 - “Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the **Name of Elohim** forever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:”

Daniel 9:6 - “Neither have we hearkened unto your servants the prophets, which spoke in your **Name** to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.”

Daniel 9:18-19 - “O my **Elohim**, incline your ear, and hear; open your eyes, and behold our desolations, and the city which is called by your **Name**: for we do not present our supplications before you for our righteousnesses, but for your great mercies. O **Yehovah**, hear; O **Yehovah**, forgive; O **Yehovah**, hearken and do; defer not, for your own sake, O my **Elohim**: for your city and your people are called by your **Name.**”

Joel 2:26 - “And you shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the **Name** of the **Yehovah** your **Elohim**, that has dealt wondrously with you: and my people shall never be ashamed.”

Joel 2:32 - “And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the Name of the Yehovah shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the **Yehovah** has said, and in the remnant whom the **Yehovah** shall call.”

Amos 4:13 - “For, lo, he that forms the mountains, and creates the wind, and declares unto man what is his thought, that makes the morning darkness, and treads upon the high places of the Earth, **The Yehovah, The Elohim of Hosts, is his Name.**”

Amos 5:8 - “Seek him that makes the seven stars and Orion, and turns the shadow of death into the morning, and makes the day dark with night: that calls for the waters of the sea, and pours them out upon the face of the Earth: **The Yehovah is his Name.**”

Amos 9:6 - “It is he that builds his stories in the Heaven, and has founded his troop in the Earth; he that calls for the waters of the sea, and pours them out upon the face of the Earth: **The Yehovah is his Name.**”

Amos 9:12 - “That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my **Name**, says the **Yehovah** that does this.”

Micah 4:5 - “For all people will walk every one in the **Name** of his **Elohim**, and we will walk in the **Name** of the **Yehovah** our **Elohim** forever and ever.”

Micah 5:4 - “And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the **Yehovah**, in the majesty of the **Name** of the **Yehovah** his **Elohim**; and they shall abide: for now shall he be great unto the ends of the Earth.”

Micah 6:9 - “The **Yehovah's** voice cries unto the city, and the man of wisdom shall see your **Name**: hear you the rod, and who has appointed it.”

Zephaniah 3:9 - “For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the Name of the Yehovah, to serve him with one consent.”

Zephaniah 3:12 - “I will also leave in the midst of you an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the **Name** of the **Yehovah**.”

Zechariah 5:4 - “I will bring it forth, saith the **Yehovah** of Hosts, and it shall enter into the house of the thief, and into the house of him that swears falsely by my **Name**: and it shall remain in the midst of his house, and shall consume it with the timber thereof and the stones thereof.”

Zechariah 6:12 - “And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaks the **Yehovah** of Hosts, saying, Behold the man whose **Name** is the branch; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the Temple of the **Yehovah**.”

Zechariah 10:12 - “And I will strengthen them in the **Yehovah**; and they shall walk up and down in his **Name**, says the **Yehovah**.”

Zechariah 13:9 - “And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my **Name**, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, The **Yehovah** is my **Elohim**.”

Zechariah 14:9 - “And the **Yehovah** shall be king over all the Earth: in that day shall there be one **Yehovah**, and his **Name** one.”

Malachi 1:11 - “For from the rising of the Sun even unto the going down of the same my **Name** shall be great among the Gentiles; and in every place incense shall be offered unto my **Name**, and a pure offering: for my **Name** shall be great among the heathen, says the **Yehovah** of Hosts.”

Malachi 2:2 - “If you will not hear, and if you will not lay it to heart, to give glory unto my **Name**, saith the **Yehovah** of Hosts, I will even send a curse upon you, and I will curse your blessings: yea, I have cursed them already, because you do not lay it to heart.”

Malachi 2:5 - “My Covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my **Name**.”

Malachi 3:16 - “Then they that feared the **Yehovah** spoke often one to another: and the **Yehovah** hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the **Yehovah**, and that thought upon his **Name**.”

Malachi 4:2 - “But unto you that fear my **Name** shall the sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and you shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.”
