

# *Trees of Olive*

*Mt. Sinai - The True Location of Mt. Sinai  
at Jabal al Lawz in Saudi Arabia  
- Location Discovered by Ron Wyatt in 1984*

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The travel route of the Israelites from the land of Goshen in Egypt to the area of Mount Sinai, and from Mount Sinai to the crossing of the Jordan River, has fascinated millions of Bible students throughout history, especially in this present time. Yet, in our present time, there are many helpful tools, books with colorful photographs, DVDs, graphics, various maps, and even YouTube videos that make historic sites come alive.

For hundreds of years it was alleged that Mount Sinai was located in the south of the Sinai Peninsula. In past years there were much archaeological researches done in this alleged area of the south of the Sinai Peninsula. In spite of the great archaeological researches that were done there was very little evidence of the Israelites having camped in this area of the southern Sinai, and of the alleged area of Mount Sinai. It must be noted that Queen Helena (of the Roman Empire) and her traveling crew wrongly designated the area in the southern Sinai Peninsula as being Mount Sinai with little factual proof. ### Three Days’ Journey to the Wilderness - From Goshen to the Outpost of Succoth, Being Out of Egypt

There have been much fascination about the term “**three days’ journey to the wilderness,**” which is mentioned in the Book of Exodus, and of the Israelites’ travel from Goshen to Succoth. The distance from the land of “**Goshen**” (the land of Rameses) to the border and strong fortification frontier of Egypt, which was an area called “**Succoth,**” is a distance called in the Tanakh (the Old Testament) a “**three days’ journey to the wilderness.**” Succoth is the borderline of Egypt. By Moses and the Israelites reaching this location of Succoth they were physically “**out of Egypt;**” and therefore, they could, and they did, hold a “**Feast unto the Great Yehovah Elohim,**” as they were commanded to do so.

In Exodus 3:18 it is written: “And they shall hearken to your voice: and you shall come, you and the elders of Israel, unto the king of Egypt, and you shall say unto him, The Yehovah Elohim of the Hebrews has met with us: and now let

us go, we beseech you, three days' journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to the Yehovah our Elohim.”

In Exodus 5:3 it is written: “And they said, The Elohim of the Hebrews has met with us: let us go, we pray you, three days' journey into the desert, and sacrifice unto the Yehovah our Elohim; lest he fall upon us with pestilence, or with the sword.”

In Exodus 8:27 it is written: “We will go three days' journey into the wilderness, and sacrifice to the Yehovah our Elohim, as he shall command us.”

The three days' journey of the Israelites' journey from Goshen to Succoth is a traveling distance that would take a person or a group of people to travel from Goshen to Succoth, which is a total traveling distance of about 54 miles, consisting of traveling about “18 miles” per day.

The standard traveling distance of many ancient trade routes, and caravans, and even of the Silk Road, was a traveling distance of about 18 miles each day. It must be noted that the traveling groups consisted of men, women and children traveling - **by walking**, and in that they had all sorts of livestock, camels, donkeys, etc. traveling along with them. The question must be asked: How many miles can livestock animals and pack animals travel each day and for many days - without any harm? When the Israelites left Egypt they had both livestock animals and pack animals with them, as well as wagons. The various pack animals were used to transport the various items that the people needed in their traveling, and for whatever riches and wealth they wanted to take with them, and many of the people had goods and merchandise that they desired to sell abroad. Secondly, some of the livestock animals were as a source of wealth, as well as a source of food. It must be noted that there were usually “**rest stops**” on many of these ancient trade and traveling routes, which were located about “18 miles” apart from one another.

54 Miles to Goshen to Succoth - Are you truly physically fit and healthy in this present time? How many men and women today could actually walk 18 miles or more per day, and 54 miles or more within three days, and to do so without any type of health problems, and especially to do so without complaining and murmuring? Imagine the people in ancient times having to travel many miles, and many hundreds, or even thousands of miles, in groups, and on caravans, and on trade routes, and in that they usually walked at least 18 miles (or more) per day in their traveling. Yes, truly, how many men and women today could travel the distance from “**Goshen**” in Egypt to the borderline of Egypt, which is the area of “**Succoth**,” and do so in three days (a three days' journey), and having to travel this distance of at least “54 miles”?

### The Travel Distance from the Area of Succoth to the Red Sea Area of Pi-hahiroth

140 Miles From Succoth to Pi-hahiroth - There is a distance of about “140 miles” from the border-fortification of Egypt (the area of Succoth) to the area of “**Pi-hahiroth**” through the barren, wilderness of the Sinai Peninsula. Moses, and the traveling Israelites

had to travel this distance of about “140 miles” in order to reach the area of Pi-hahiroth. How many men and women today could travel by walking this distance of about 140 miles, and to do at least 18 miles per day, and to do so in about eight days (considering 140 miles divided by 18 miles per day = 8 days)? Yes, how many?

In Exodus 14:1-3 it is written: “And the Yehovah spoke unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they turn and encamp before Pi-hahiroth, between Migdol and the sea, over against Baal-zephon: before it shall you encamp by the sea. For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, They are entangled in the land, the wilderness has shut them in.”

In Exodus 14:8-9 it is written: “And the Yehovah hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with an high hand. But the Egyptians pursued after them, all the horses and chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen, and his army, and overtook them encamping by the sea, beside Pi-hahiroth, before Baal-zephon.”

In Numbers 33:6-9 it is written: “And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which is in the edge of the wilderness. And they removed from Etham, and turned again unto Pi-hahiroth, which is before Baal-zephon: and they pitched before Migdol. And they departed from before Pi-hahiroth, and passed through the midst of the Sea into the wilderness, and went three days' journey in the wilderness of Etham, and pitched in Marah.”

### The Travel Distance from the Area of Pi-hahiroth to Across the Midst of the Red Sea, to Baal-Zephon

11.2 Miles Across the Red Sea - Do you know the distance from Pi-hahiroth (Nuweiba Beach) to across the Red Sea (to the area of Baal-zephon in Saudi Arabia) of traveling through the mighty waters and waves of the Red Sea? The distance from the area of Pi-hahiroth (Nuweiba Beach) to across the Red Sea to the area of Baal-zephon is a distance of about “11.2 miles” (18 kilometers). The Israelites had to travel this distance through the midst of the Red Sea in order to reach the opposite shore of the Red Sea. Secondly, the Israelites had to walk this distance in the “midst of the Red Sea,” and in that they did so in the “middle of the NIGHT” in order to reach the other side of the Red Sea shore - to the area of Baal-zephon, which is located in present day area of Saudi Arabia.

In Exodus 14:13-31 it is written: “And Moses said unto the people, Fear you not, stand still, and see the Salvation of the Yehovah, which he will shew to you today: for the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you shall see them again no more forever. The Yehovah shall fight for you, and you shall hold your peace. And the Yehovah said unto Moses, Wherefore cry you unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: But lift you up your

**rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.** And I, behold, I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them: and I will get me honor upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen. And the Egyptians shall know that I am the Yehovah, when I have gotten me honor upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen. And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them: And it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel; and it was a cloud and darkness to them, **but it gave light by night to these:** so that the one came not near the other **all the night.** And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the Yehovah caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind **all that night,** and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided. And the children of Israel went **into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground:** and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, even all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen. And it came to pass, that **in the morning** watch the Yehovah looked unto the host of the Egyptians through the pillar of fire and of the cloud, and troubled the host of the Egyptians, And took off their chariot wheels, that they drove them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; for the Yehovah fights for them against the Egyptians. And the Yehovah said unto Moses, Stretch out your hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians, upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen. And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength **when the morning appeared;** and the Egyptians fled against it; and the Yehovah overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea. And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, and all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them. But the children of Israel walked upon dry land in the midst of the sea; and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left. Thus the Yehovah saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians; and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the seashore. And Israel saw that great work which the Yehovah did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the Yehovah, and believed the Yehovah, and his servant Moses.”

**Nearly 2000 Miles of Traveling for the Israelites** - In taking the time and just calculating the **walking** distance of the Israelites' deliverance from Goshen in Egypt, to the area of the Jordan River (just before crossing the Jordan River to conquer Canaan Land) there had to have been a distance of at least from 1800 to 2000 miles that the Israelites had to travel - by **WALKING** - and to do so at the command of the Great Yehovah Elohim - in order to reach their Canaan Land - to their beautiful, blessed, Land of Milk and Honey.

## Being Physically Fit at All Times, and Loving to Walk, and to Enjoy Walking and Hiking Trips

In considering that Moses and the Israelites had to “WALK” many long distances, and especially had to do so at the “command” of the Great Yehovah, there are many times that I consider these things, and I ask and Pray to the true and Great Yehovah to help me get my physical body in perfect, physical shape, including in being able to walk over 18 miles per day, and even longer distances, and in walking long distances for many days, especially in order to be able to fully enjoy long hiking trips, and even in being able to do so, and to do indeed do so, in traveling the ancient travel routes of the Israelites from the land area of Goshen to the Succoth, and from Succoth to Nuweiba Beach (Pi-hahiroth), and even to Mount Sinai (Jabal al Lawz) in Saudi Arabia. I look forward to seeing the day when there are excellent travel and hiking excursions being made available for men, women and children, and for vacation travel groups, to go on, especially during these next 1000 years of this blessed, Seventh Millennium here on our physical, blessed, beautiful, **GOOD Earth** that the true and Great God - the Great Yehovah Elohim has graciously given to us.

Are we in this modern times, because of having living in the Cities and Towers of Babel of this Earth in past years, truly physically fit and healthy; and yes indeed, how many today can actually walk 18 miles or more a day, and do so for many days - even at the command of the Great Yehovah? May the Great Yehovah help all of us, because of having living in the Cities of Babel of this Earth in past years, truly become healthy, strong and physically fit in every area.

A healthy person could walk at least three miles (or more) per hour, and at least ten hours per day, and totally 30 miles (or more). Traveling a distance of 18 miles can be achieved within six hours, yet having to consider traveling with animals, and also having to consider rest periods throughout the day, it probably would take at least eight or more hours to travel a distance of 18 miles per day. Traveling a distance of only 18 miles per day, and in having rest periods are not overtiring to oneself, nor to the various types of animals.

May everyone get their physical body in perfect, physical shape, including in always being healthy, strong and physically fit at all times, especially in order to be able to always go wherever the true and Great Yehovah has for each of us to go, and to be able to do whatever the Great Yehovah has for each of us to do, and to do so without any type of complaining, nor murmuring; and to do so in perfect, physical shape at all times, and also to fully **Enjoy WALKING and Traveling** throughout this blessed, beautiful Earth.

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
